Broadway Academy of Performing is a Music Theater camp for students aged 11-20 years.

- ❖ Students will audition for, rehearse, and perform a fully mounted musical production of the musical, *Guys and Dolls* (June 15-22) and/or *7 Brides for 7 Brothers* (July 27-Aug 3) at Newman University in Wichita, KS.
- ❖ Camp faculty and staff will be led by Alison Bridget Chambers, adjunct lecturer at Newman University. Other faculty and staff bring professional performance and teaching experience to the camp.
- ❖ Final days for registration are June 6th, 2019 for *Guys and Dolls* and July 18, 2019 for *7 Brides for 7 Brothers*. A \$100 deposit is required at the time of registration. Deposits for the camp are refundable through registration deadline. Total cost per camp is \$375. This includes cost of meals, lodging, instruction, production materials, and a camp T-shirt.
- ❖ Students can attend one or both camp sessions.
